## CASE STUDIES:

### Tate Britain Gallery, Millbank London

**Project Value: £45m**

Extensive two year refurbishment and restoration project to the original 19th Century galleries within Tate Britain.



The project saw a requirement for high specification doorsets which included the supply of fumed oak book-matched veneer faced doors with oak edges and frames.

There were also a number of specialist curved head doorsets in horizontal/vertical stiled fumed oak with inlays to suit existing wall openings. Along with doorsets, veneered wall panelling was also supplied to match the fumed oak veneer finish on the doorsets. Approx. 200nr doorsets and over 200nr wall panels were supplied in total.

Tate Britain re-opened its doors to the public November 2013.

### Birmingham New Street Station & Grand Central Shopping Centre

**Combined Project Value: £100m**



Extensive redevelopment and refurbishment to the existing Railway Station Concourse Area and former Pallasades Shopping Centre including the construction of a brand new John Lewis Flagship Store.

A total of 400nr. doorsets are being supplied comprising of paint-grade, laminate, acrovyn post-formed, and veneer faced doorsets, all manufactured from our Fortis range. A number of these doorsets require a 2hour fire-resistance which shall be manufactured from our Ignis range of doorsets constructed using specialist materials. All doorsets shall be supplied complete with hinges and architraves.

The project is due for overall completion in 2015.

### Telford Community Hub & MSCP Southwater One development

**Project Value: £12m**

Construction of a brand-new community hub to house new library, council and tourist information, bars, restaurants and other community services.

A mix of 150nr. paint-grade and laminate faced doorsets were supplied along with side-screens, fanlights and glass, plus architraves and hinges. The project is due for completion mid 2014.



### Kensington Central Library

**Project Value: £5.8m**

Internal refurbishment and alterations to the library to provide improved community facilities.



Approx 60nr crown-cut Steamed Beech veneer faced doors with primed frames will be supplied along with hinges and architraves as a complete package.

### Dominion Arts Centre, Southall

**Project Value: £3m**



Extension and alterations to existing centre to house all community facilities on one site including a library & meeting space.

Approx 50nr. paint-grade doors with primed frames and laminate faced doors with maple frames were supplied along with side-screens, glass and architraves as a complete package.
