



CASE STUDIES:

Tate Britain, Millbank London

Project Value: £45m



Extensive two year refurbishment and restoration project to the original 19th Century galleries within Tate Britain.

The project saw a requirement for high specification doorsets which included:

- 200nr doorsets and over 200nr wall panels supplied
- supply of Fumed Oak book-matched veneer faced doors with Oak edges pre-hung in Oak frames
- Number of specialist curved head doorsets in horizontal/ vertical stiled Fumed Oak veneer with inlays to suit existing wall openings
- Veneered wall panelling was also supplied to provide an exact match to the Fumed Oak veneer finish on the doorsets

Birmingham New Street Station & Grand Central Shopping Centre

Combined Project Value: £100m



Extensive redevelopment and refurbishment to the existing Railway Station Concourse Area and former Pallasades Shopping Centre in Birmingham.

Doorsets:

- 400nr doorsets supplied in total
- Mixture of paint-grade, laminate, acrovyn post-formed, and veneer faced doorsets
- Number of these doorsets were fire-rated to 120 minutes
- All doorsets were supplied with hinges and architraves for a complete pre-hung doorset

Telford Community Hub & MSCP

Project Value: £12m



Construction of a brand-new community hub to house new library, council & tourist information, bars, restaurants and other community services.

A mix of 150nr. paint-grade and laminate faced doorsets were supplied along with side-screens, fanlights and glass, plus architraves and hinges for a complete pre-hung doorset.

The Corn Exchange, Manchester

Project Value: £30m



A £30 million transformation of the existing building to provide a restaurant/leisure destination in the heart of Manchester known as the 'Corn Exchange'.

Once complete, 12 restaurants will take occupancy within the building on the ground floor, whilst an 86-bedroom boutique hotel will occupy the upper floors of the building.

Doorsets:

- All doorsets to be supplied paint-grade primed for on-site decoration
- Factory machining of non-protruding ironmongery
- Manufactured to standard sizes

The Corn Exchange is due to open Summer 2015.

Tate Modern, Southwark

Project Value: £215m



A state-of-the-art 76m high, 11 storey extension to the existing Tate Modern art gallery, providing increased exhibition & display space, and education facilities for schools.

Doorsets:

- Bespoke quarter-cut stained European Oak veneered doors with stained Oak frames
- Number of the doors were acoustic rated to 42dB for sound reduction.
- Acoustic insulation was added to the core of the sliding doors for added acoustic performance
